

Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)

All students, who have decided to enter the Nursing Program, must complete the TEAS, Test of Essential Academic Skills, at a required level in order to be admitted into the program. A strong knowledge in the areas of English, mathematics, science, and reading comprehension correlates to a higher probability of success in the Nursing Program.

TEAS testing locations can be accessed at www.atitesting.com. You must register and pay for the test online at ATI Testing at least 48 hours in advance.

Make sure of your selections, any issues you are having need to be directed to ATI Customer Service at 1-800-667-7531. All registrations are final and will not be refunded.

Registration Information for Capital Region BOCES:

Capital Region BOCES offers the TEAS test (paper pencil version) throughout the year. Capital Region BOCES can be reached at www.capitalregionboces.org or by telephone at (518) 862-4709 to register for the TEAS test at their location.

We also accept ATI TEAS scores from other testing sites.

Score Requirements:

SUNY FMCC requires a TEAS test minimum score of proficient level to be admitted into the program. The TEAS test must be taken within two years of the application date. The TEAS test can only be taken twice in a twelve-month period. A repeat test attempt may not be earlier than 30 days and must be an ATI proctored test. Students repeating the TEAS test are advised to utilize study guide materials prior to making a second attempt.

Please note, test attempts at other testing sites will count as an attempt. Scores of a second attempt prior to 30 days will not be accepted. If you do not meet the TEAS cut score, you must retake the entire TEAS test.

SUNY FMCC follows ATI TEAS testing recommendations.
