Duties include tutoring, mentoring, student engagement programming, creating, and maintaining connections with students, helping with goal setting, home visits (when needed), assistance with food pantry and backpack programs, and other duties as assigned.

Qualifications: Associate's minimum w/ applicable experience working with students or Bachelor's degree preferred.

Salary: Hourly pay rate is based upon education level and varies from \$17-\$20 per hour; up to 25 hours per week; including a limited summer program. Hours vary slightly but are primarily during school hours. Limited evening and weekend hours may be required.
