Part-Time Academic Mentor & History Tutor

The LPP program at FMCC serves 360 students in grades 6-12 in the Amsterdam School District and is a student success program with the goal of helping our students succeed and graduate on time and on track for post-high school success. FM is seeking applications from creative, energetic and enthusiastic individuals to serve as a part time, Mentor/History Tutor for our LPP students. This position is based at the Amsterdam High School not at the college. We are looking for those specifically with the ability and knowledge to tutor in history courses (Global, US History, Government, etc) and mentor high school students. We are looking for someone to help our students find success as they navigate high school and look towards college readiness. As such the position is roughly 70% mentoring, student engagement programming, goal setting with students (individual meetings with students on a weekly basis) and 30% tutoring. You would be joining a well-established team who together offer professional development support, creation of “curriculum” for mentoring meetings and help with all programming. It is an incredible team and rewarding program to join!

Qualifications:

Required-Associate’s in History and previous tutoring experience, knowledge and ability to relate to culturally diverse students. ***Must be good at using Excel, and Google Docs.***

Preferred: Bachelor’s in History. Spanish language fluency.

Duties include but not limited to: Academic tutoring, record keeping/database entry, managing and mentoring a caseload of 35-40 students, etc.

Salary: \$15-\$17 per hour; 29 hours per week during the public school academic year (September-June); hours vary slightly but will follow a 8:30 am -2:30 pm schedule. It is a Monday-Friday position. There is possibility of summer employment as well (into early August).
